Born in New Brunswick, Chauncey Donald Orchard moved to British Columbia in 1920 to join the British Columbia Forest Service after graduating from the University of New Brunswick. He served in the Forest Service for almost forty years as Chief Forester and became British Columbia's first Deputy Minister of Forests.

The records include subject files, letterbooks, diaries, scrapbooks, photos, a manuscript relating to his personal and family life, to his work as a forester, and as Chief Forester, to his work as a forestry consultant, and to his activities as a collector of material relating to the forest history of British Columbia.
