William A. Scott was born in England and lived in China as a lighthouse keeper from 1923-1939. After 1939 he moved to Victoria, B.C.

Records include subject files reflecting his interest in philosophy, civil liberties, local politics; correspondence, reports and diaries re life and work in China; family papers and correspondence.

Photographs include 223 prints, 100 negatives, and 2 transparencies, transferred to Visual Records accession 197906-1. Subjects include: Chinese lighthouses, Scott's home and contacts in Oak Bay, and publicity photographs.
