Political correspondence, caucus minutes, and reports accumulated by David Barrett during his last year as Leader of the Opposition and Leader of the British Columbia New Democratic Party. Mr. Barrett, who was premier of the province from 1972 to 1975, resigned the leadership of the NDP in 1983; he retired from the Legislature (where he represented the riding of Coquitlam) in 1984.

The records which comprise MS-2179 were transferred to the Provincial Archives from the NDP caucus offices in the Parliament Buildings in November 1985. This material is a continuation of a larger collection of records catalogued as MS-2120.
