Mr. Barrett, who was premier of the province from 1972 to 1975, resigned the leadership of the NDP in 1983; he retired from the Legislature (where he represented the riding of Coquitlam) in 1984.

The records which comprise MS-2179 were transferred to the Provincial Archives from the NDP caucus offices in the Parliament Buildings in November 1985. This material is a continuation of a larger collection of records catalogued as MS-2120.
