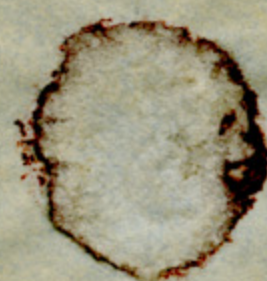

Dear Mr. Hanson Esq.



Dear Sir

After a tiresome walk I arrived my third day early, found all safe and my family in good health thank God.

During my absence an Indian of the Sadsuck band made his appearance here and brought a handsome hunt upward of 40 m^{ts}. He is the only Sadsuck Indian I have seen since my charge of Nantlay. I hope more of them may cast up before Spring.

The Horses etc are in good condition, and I still have a sufficient quantity of hay to keep them about the Fort till the Spring.

My Stock of Potmow is almost at a decline and of the quality not eatable, however I must try to make out till I meet you at Chinlac Fort, when I shall expect a supply from

you for the summer consumption.

I hope by the first opportunity you will be kind enough to send me the balance for miss. the two pounds given last fall on the Oulfit I have used being up the Martins.

Nothing particular to add I remain

My Stock of Salmon is almost at a decline and of the quality not eatable, however I must try to make out till I meet you at Chinlac forks when I shall expect a supply from you for the summer consumption.

I hope by the first opportunity you will be kind enough to send me 6 lb Twine for nets. the two pounds given last fall on the Outfit I have used tying up the Martens.
