Offerside James Bay - On Wallace Road - Got to Chinatown about 10:45 - Stood at counter of Heek Lung a few minutes & then went up stairs to my room - Chin Sam - Mah Yook - & Chin Ling - yee King - & manager Nep Ng - were here - all but manager are room mates of mine - I did not leave the room at all - Went to bed 10 to 12 - All were there talking & want to know why I went to bed so early - Got up 7:30 - Know Charley Sirp - Thought he was gap. Did not assault him. Did not use iron bar. Was not at theatre. Chin Ling asked me - I did not want to go.

Went to bed 10 to 12 & slept but they talked 1 hour after

Chin Ling = Cook - Mr. H. Saunders - Was at my room at 11 P.M. Saty. night - All 6 of us were there - same tribe as prosecutor - Heard first of assault on Sunday night +

Chin Sam. Cook - Mr. Dunsun. Remember Saty. 2nd Feb. Saw See Hong - at room at 11 - Stayed all the time - Hong went to bed first. ~~He~~ Went to bed after 12 - Same tribe as prosecutor -



Lee Sam - Foreman of Camery.

That night I was with Chui Ah Goom. Went there nearly 11 o'clock. Took money there & gave him \$15. Stayed there 1/2 hour - asked him to take lunch & we went to Restaurant on Cormorant St & we had supper. (Hong Fa).

Eating until abt. 12.30 - see Lee Yu There. The manager - He waited on us. Heard of the assault at 20' clock Sunday. Was not at theatre that night - did not see Charlie Ah Ding - Saw Chui Yee King that night - He was watching 2nd door of white man's gambling house, Fisguard St. He has watched the door there 1/2 hrs - going to small ~~camery~~ camery on Sheena

Chui (Ah) Goom - Camery Labourer - live back of King Tai. Dont remember night of assault - Remember 2nd Feb: Went out at 9 heard of it. Saw Lee Sam that night. He bit me some money - 11 P.M. We went to supper - to Hong Fa. Got through abt 12.20 Lee Yu was there in the bar. Went up the street. Know Chui Yee King - There is a clock in the restaurant

Lee Yu - Restaurantkeeper - (Hong Fa) Cormorant St - heard of assault - Remember night - Saw Lee Sam in Restaurant - with Chui Goom - abt 11.30 - they had supper. Till 12.30 - I waited on them

Wing Kee - China store - Cormorant St. Been here since 1871.



Yee Bing - Tailor - roommate of Seetung.
Remember Saturday night - Six were there

Wep Ng = merchant - Fisguard St - Foin
name Yick Lung - Remember Saturday - About
11 was at counter - Saw Lee Hung abt 11:30 - Up

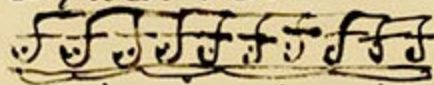

shoemaker - Wong ngo - Stayed there a
little over 2 hours - Went back to Quong ong lung
Stayed there all the time - Went to bed almost one
o'clock - Was talking in opium room - The
Cook, the worker & the manager were there
We were in 2nd room from the counters.
Board partition between rooms - did not
assault Charlie Simpson. Next day abt noon
a man came from the brickyard & told about - On
Sunday heard abt. assault - Was arrested at the
Police station - The foreman of brickyard was with
me - Wm Bull I was laying complaint -
Was up stairs in theatre = second row next to

See same alone of those arrested I knew & two
together arrested by one policeman = I was there
when same searched - All were there - Chief
Sheppard was there. He was not the one that searched
me.

at store abt. 8 o'clock. Went to theatre with him.
Stayed there over 2 hrs. Went back to store - at
almost 11. Stayed smoking opium - abt 2 hrs.
Went to bed. Nearly one o'clock. There were
several in store on retn. fm theatre.

Lee Yu Chung. Merchant. 32 Cormorant St.
Lee dip hum stays at my place - Remember 2 Feb.
Got home in store - ~~at 10 p.m.~~ went to theatre
with Wong Ngo. They got back a little before
11. We usually close 11 sharp. When they came
in fm. theatre I was writing - I wrote pretty late
that night. Can hear sounds thro' partition.
They went into smoking room & back while I go
to bed a few mts. before 1. I do! late
enough for all to go to bed. I locked store
at 11.

At 11th ^{At 10th At 10th} me & porter & cook were in store.
at 11 - No outside people. Very short time
before 11.
