- 1. That in the year 1913, I owned a house in South Wellington, in which I lived; and I had in that house a stock of leather; and shoes; tools for repairing shoes; and some grocery provisions.
- 2. I had lived in the house for two years prior to 1913.

 In the second week in August, 1913, a number of white
 men strikers came to South Wellington. They carried guns,
 sticks and hammers, and were shouting and driving the Chinese out
 from their houses.
- 3. At this disturbance, I was much frightened and ran away, hiding in the woods all night. Next morning, as soon as there was light enough, I went on to Ladysmith, hiding in the bush by the wayside if I saw anyone.
