Grace and health. Whereas ye are  
as it is alleged resolved to proceed to the solemniza-  
tion of true and lawful Matrimony, you  
being both of the age of twenty one years and  
upwards, and that you greatly desire that the  
same may be solemnized in the face of the  
Church: We therefore being willing, that these  
your reasonable desires may the more speedily  
obtain a due effect, and to the end thereof that  
this marriage may be publicly and lawfully  
solemnized at the said Fort Vancouver by the  
Chaplain thereof without the publication or pro-  
clamation of the Banns of Matrimony,  
provided there shall appear no impediment  
of kindred, or alliance, or any other lawful cause,  
nor any suit commenced in any Ecclesiastical  
Court, to bar or hinder the proceeding of the

said Matrimony according to the tenor of  
this Licence; and likewise that the celebration  
of this marriage be had and done publicly  
at the aforesaid Fort Vancouver between the  
hours of eight and twelve in the forenoon.  
We for lawful cause graciously grant this our  
Licence and Faculty, as well to you the party  
contracting, as to the aforesaid Chaplain who  
is assigned to solemnize the marriage between  
you in the manner and form above specified,  
according to the Rites of the Book of Com-  
-mon Prayer, set forth for that purpose  
by the Authority of Parliament.
