jurors unknown feloniously and
unlawfully did shoot with intent
thereby then feloniously wilfully and
of his malice aforethought ^{the said} person
to the jurors unknown to kill and
murder against the form of the
Statute in such Case made
and provided and against the
peace of our Lady the Queen
her Crown and dignity.

2 And the juror aforesaid
upon their Oath aforesaid do further
present that the said Ali Luon
afterwards to wit on the day and
year aforesaid a certain pistol
then loaded with gunpowder and
silver leaden bullets which he the
said Ali Luon in his hand then

had and held at and against
a person ^{whose name is} to the jurors unknown
feloniously unlawfully and
maliciously did shoot with
intent in so doing to kill the
said person to the jurors unknown
thereby then to offend against
the form of the Statute in
such case made and provided
and against the peace of our
Lady the Queen her Crown
and dignity.

3. And the Jurors aforesaid
upon their oath aforesaid do
further present that the said
Abraham afterwards to wit on
the day and year aforesaid a certain
pistol then loaded with gunpowder
and divers leaden bullets which he
the said Abraham in his hand then
had and held at and against
a person ^{whose name is} to the jurors unknown
feloniously unlawfully and maliciously
did shoot with intent in so doing
to kill the said person whose name
is to the jurors unknown thereby
then to offend against the
form of the Statute in such
case made and provided and
against the peace of our Lady
the Queen her Crown and
dignity.



4 And the jurors aforesaid upon
them both aforesaid do further present
that the said Al Leon afterwards
to wit on the day and year
aforesaid a certain pistol then
loaded with gunpowder and divers
leaden bullets which he the said
Al Leon in his hand then had
and held at and against a
person whose name is to the
jurors unknown feloniously unlawfully
and maliciously did shoot with
intent in so doing him the said
person whose name is to the jurors
unknown thereby then to disable
against the form of the Statute in
such Case made and provided
and against the peace of our Lady
the Queen her Crown and dignity.

5 And the jurors aforesaid
upon them both aforesaid do further
present that the said Al Leon
afterwards to wit on the day and
year aforesaid a certain pistol then
loaded with gunpowder and divers
leaden bullets which he the said
Al Leon in his hand then had and
held at and against a person
whose name is to the jurors
unknown feloniously unlawfully
and maliciously did shoot



with intent in so doing him the
 said person whose name is to the
 jurors unknown feloniously unlawfully
 and maliciously did first with
~~intent in so doing him the said~~
~~person~~ thereby they to disfigure do
 some grievous bodily harm against
 the form of the statute in such case
 made and provided and against
 the peace of our Lady the Queen
