Dear Sir

I am notified by the Commissioners of Customs that I shall have to supply Labour on the Road leading from the Prairies to the Bremer Landing, and as it may be well known to you, that my land lies on the opposite side, where the old Sandstone Road runs, which is by far more required to be kept in repair and travelling order, I would, as well as my nearest Neighbours prefer to work on our own side, as it would be very unreasonable for us to have our settlements on such times, when we may be called upon to supply Labour, which is quite out of our district, and sometimes

not possible to cross.
