

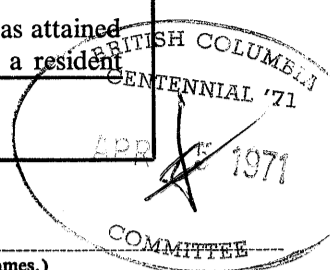


APPLICATION FOR THE CENTENARIAN AWARD
