One thousand eight hundred and eighty five
 feloniously have in his possession in the City of
 Victoria in the Province of British Columbia
 Dominion of Canada certain goods and chattels
 to wit: Eight Table knives Eleven Butter-knives nine
 Table Forks Eighteen Teaspoons Eighteen Table
 Spoons Three napkin rings One Pocket Knife
 One Watch Two Watch Chains Two Rings
 Eleven Brooches Eleven Pair of Earrings five Watch
 charms and Six Shaft Pins the property of
 the Northern Pacific Railway Company before
 they feloniously stolen ^{taken} at Seattle Washington
 Territory in the United States of America
 by the said Bing Long at the time when he
 had the said property in his possession ~~in~~
 the Dominion of Canada ^{to wit}
~~the said goods and chattels~~ ^{as aforesaid} have been feloniously stolen
